**ORDER:**

Government hereby order revision of Dearness Allowance in the Government order 12<sup>th</sup> read above in respect of Government employees in the Andhra Pradesh Revised Pay Scales, 1993 **from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2007** as indicated below:

Pay Range	Cumulative Rate of Dearness Allowance
Basic Pay up to Rs.6,380/- p.m.	152.90 % of Basic Pay subject to a maximum of Rs.9755/- per month.
Basic pay above Rs.6,380/- p.m. and up to Rs.9820/-p.m.	128.96% of Basic Pay subject to a minimum of Rs.9755/- and a maximum of Rs.12664/- per month.
Basic pay above Rs.9,820/- p.m.	117 % of Basic Pay subject to a minimum of Rs.12664/- per month.

2. The Dearness Allowance sanctioned in the above para shall also be payable to:
  - i) The employees of Zilla Parishad, Mandal Parishad, Gram Panchayats, Municipalities, Municipal Corporations, Agricultural Market Committees and Zilla Grandhalaya Samasthas, Work Charged Establishment, who are drawing pay in a regular scale of pay in the Revised Pay Scales, 1993.
  - ii) Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff of Aided Institutions including Aided Polytechnics who are drawing pay in a regular scale of pay in the Revised Pay Scales, 1993.
  - iii) Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff of Universities including the Acharya N.G. Ranga Agricultural University, the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University who are drawing pay in a regular scale of pay in the Revised Pay Scales, 1993.

3.1. Government also order for revision of the rates of Dearness Allowance sanctioned in the order 11<sup>th</sup> read above in respect of employees drawing pay in the U.G.C .Pay Scales, 1986 from 1<sup>st</sup>, January, 2007 as indicated below:

Pay Range	Cumulative Rate of Dearness Allowance
Basic pay up to Rs.3,500/- p.m.	361% of basic pay
Basic pay above Rs.3,500/- p.m. and up to Rs.6,000/- p.m.	270 % of basic pay subject to a minimum of Rs.12635/- p.m. and a maximum of Rs.16200/- p.m.
Basic pay above Rs.6,000/- p.m.	234 % of basic pay subject to a minimum of Rs.16200/- p.m.

3.2. The above revised rates of Dearness Allowance are also applicable to:

- The Teaching and Non-teaching staff of Government and Aided Affiliated Degree Colleges and Polytechnics who are drawing pay in the Revised UGC Pay Scales, 1986.
- The Teaching and Non-teaching staff of the Universities, including the Acharya N.G. Ranga Agricultural University, the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University who are drawing pay in a regular scale of pay in the Revised UGC Pay Scales, 1986.

4. The procedural instructions issued in the G.O. 13<sup>th</sup> above revising the rates of Dearness Allowance from 1<sup>st</sup>, January, 2007 in respect of employees drawing Andhra Pradesh Revised Pay Scales, 2005, Andhra Pradesh Revised Pay Scales,1999 and Revised U.G.C. Pay Scales,1996 shall be applicable in this case also.
