**ORDER:**

In continuation of the orders issued in the reference 4th read above, Government hereby order the revision of rates of Dearness Relief at the rates indicated below from **01.01.2007** in respect of those who retired drawing A.P. Revised Pay Scales, 1993 and whose pension has not been consolidated.

1.1.2007	152.90% of basic pension subject to a maximum of Rs.4878/- p.m.	128.96% of basic pension subject to a minimum of Rs.4878/- and a maximum of Rs.6332/- p.m.	117% of basic pension subject to a minimum of Rs.6332/- p.m.

2. Government also hereby order the revision of rates of Dearness Relief at the rates indicated below from **01.01.2007** to the Pensioners who retired while drawing A.P. Revised UGC Pay Scales of 1986 and whose pension has not been consolidated.

From	Revised rates of Dearness Relief		
	Pension upto Rs.1750/- p.m.	Pension above Rs.1750/- and up to Rs.3000/- p.m.	Pension above Rs.3000/- p.m.
1.1.2007	361% of basic pension subject to a maximum of Rs.6318/- p.m.	270% of basic pension subject to a minimum of Rs.6318/- and a maximum of Rs.8100/- p.m.	234% of basic pension subject to a minimum of Rs.8100/- p.m.

3. Government also here by order the revision of rates of Dearness Relief with effect from 01.01.2007 as follows, to the Pensioners who retired from A.P. Higher Judicial Services and A.P. State Judicial Service after 1-7-1996 and continue to draw pension based on the Revised Pay Scales 1993:

<b>Pensions/Family pension per month</b>	<b>Rate of Dearness Relief per month</b>
Basic Pension upto Rs.3190/- p.m.	<b>78%</b> of basic pension/ family pension subject to a maximum of Rs.2489/- p.m.
Basic Pension above Rs.3190/- p.m. and upto Rs.4910/- p.m.	<b>58%</b> of basic pension/ family pension subject to a minimum of Rs.2489/- and subject to a maximum of Rs.2848/- p.m.
Basic Pension above Rs.4910/- p.m.	<b>50%</b> of basic pension/ family pension subject to minimum of Rs.2848/- p.m.

5. The procedural instructions issued in the G.O.6<sup>th</sup> read above revising the rates of Dearness Relief from **1<sup>st</sup> January, 2007** shall be applicable in the above cases also.

**6. The arrears of the revised Dearness Relief to Pensioners from 1.1.2007 to 30.6.2007 shall be paid along with the pension of July 2007 payable in August 2007.**
